- Two Library buildings recently renovated in the heart of campus
 - Judge S. Price Gilbert Memorial Library (1953)
 - Dorothy M. Crosland Tower (1969)
- Clough Undergraduate Learning Commons attached to Library
- Shared high-density/high-tech storage facility with Emory University at Emory
- Library Records Center off campus
- ~100 Library Employees (2/3 staff, 1/3 faculty)
- 99% of circulation is electronic
- Diverse leadership team
- Lean organization operates on project management

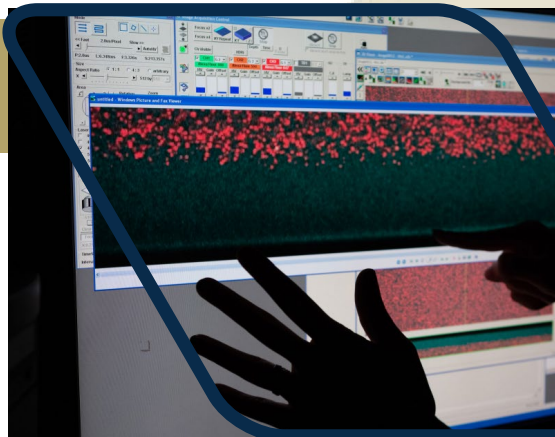

- Supports our students

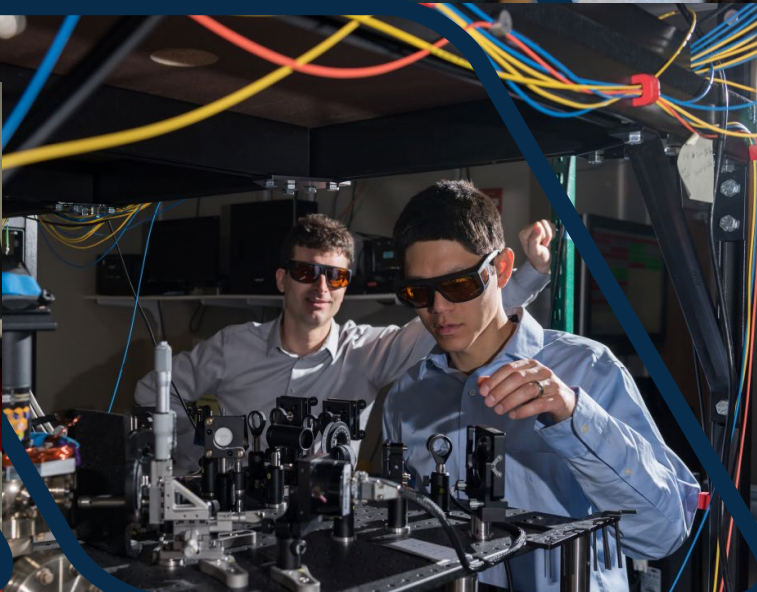
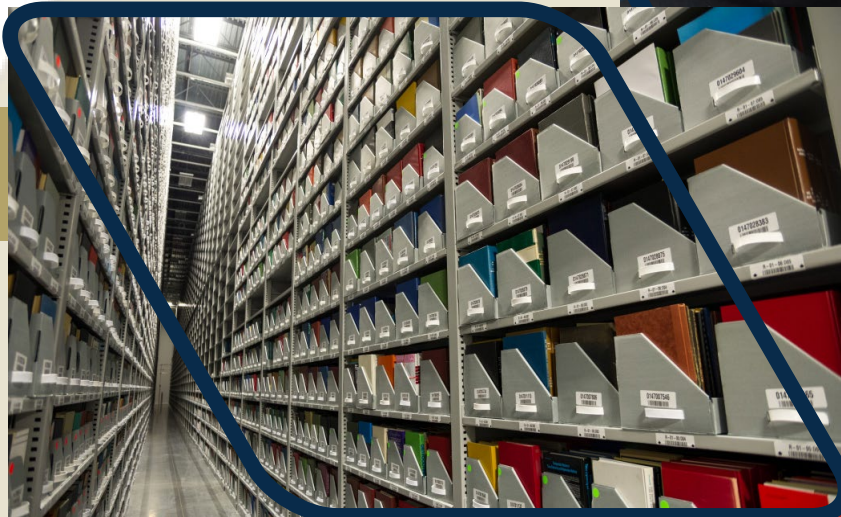

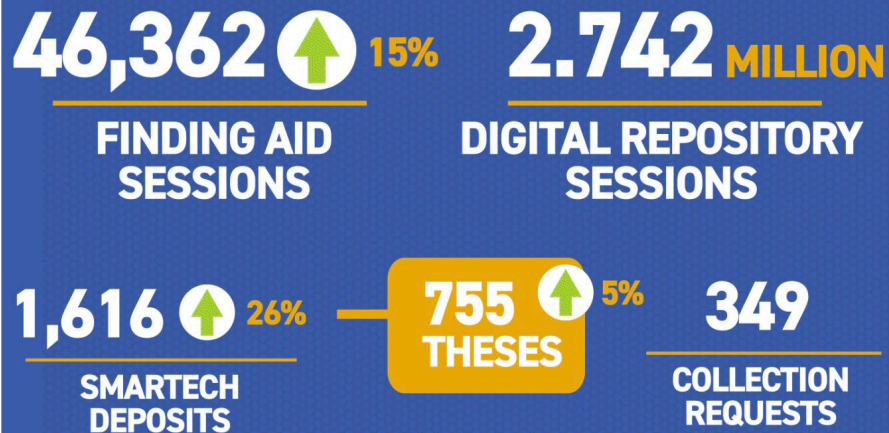

- Never say NO, if asked to submit

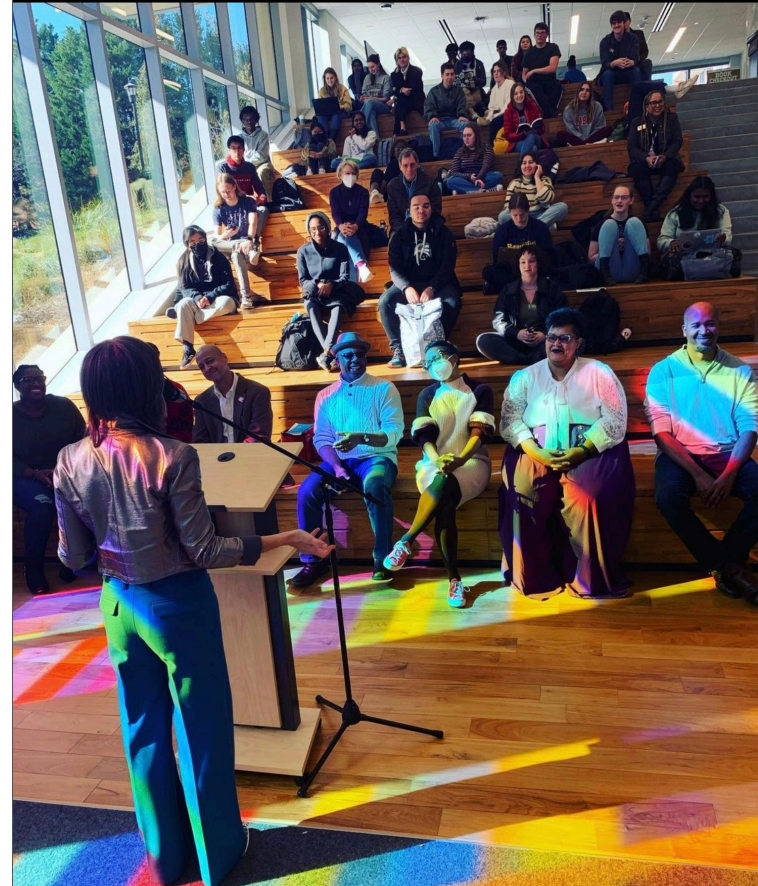


PEOPLE DEVELOPMENT

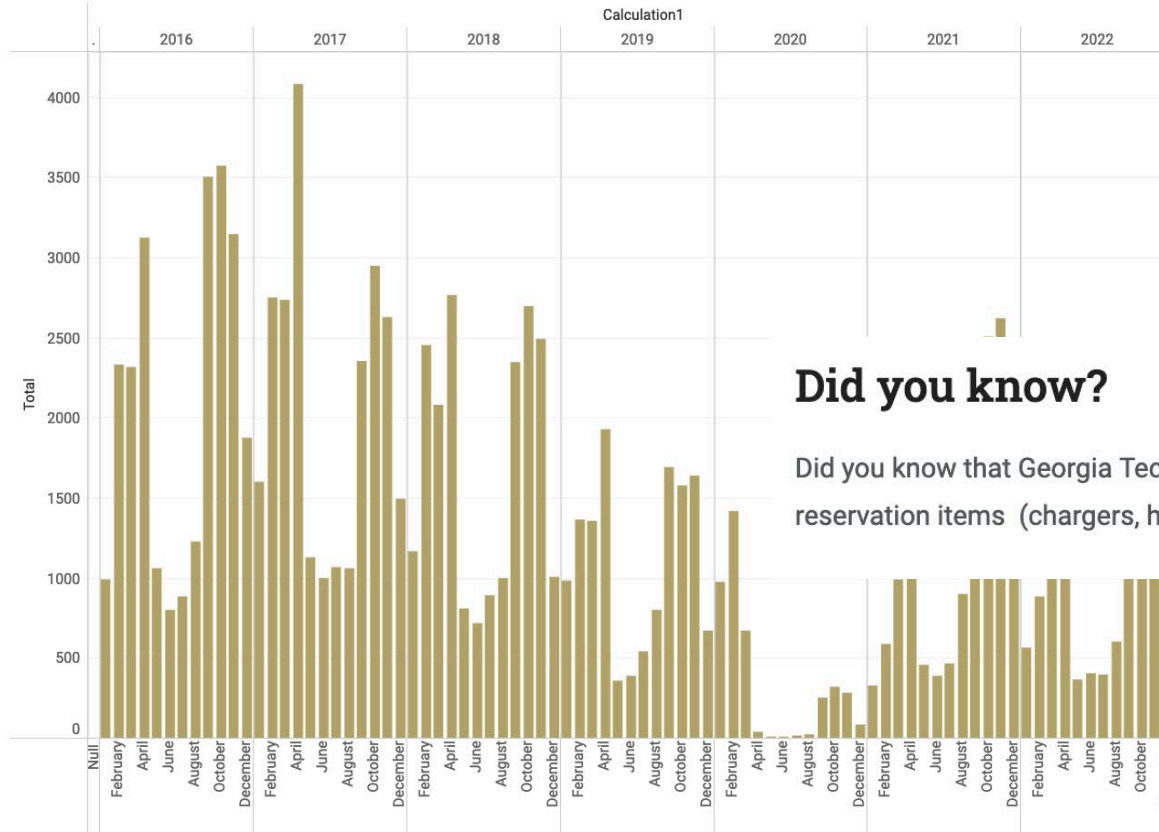

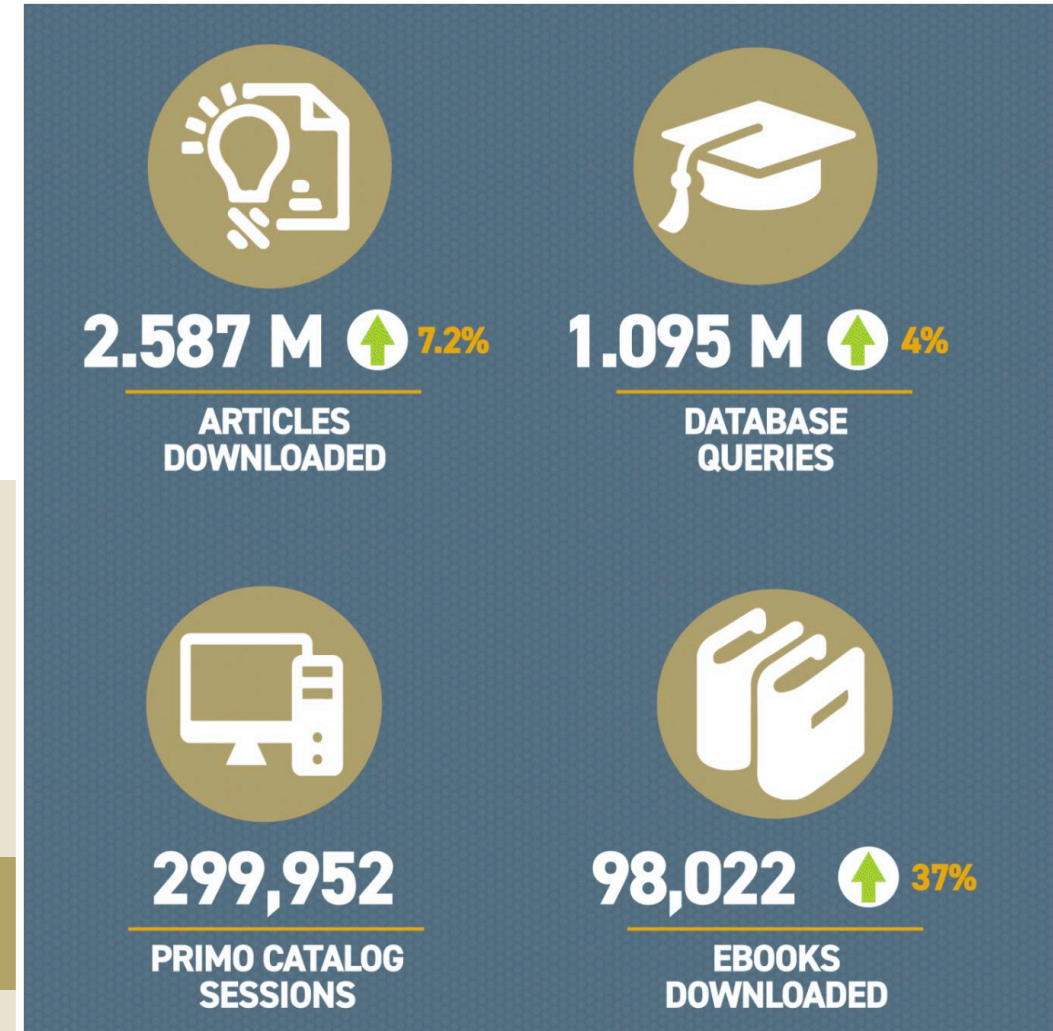
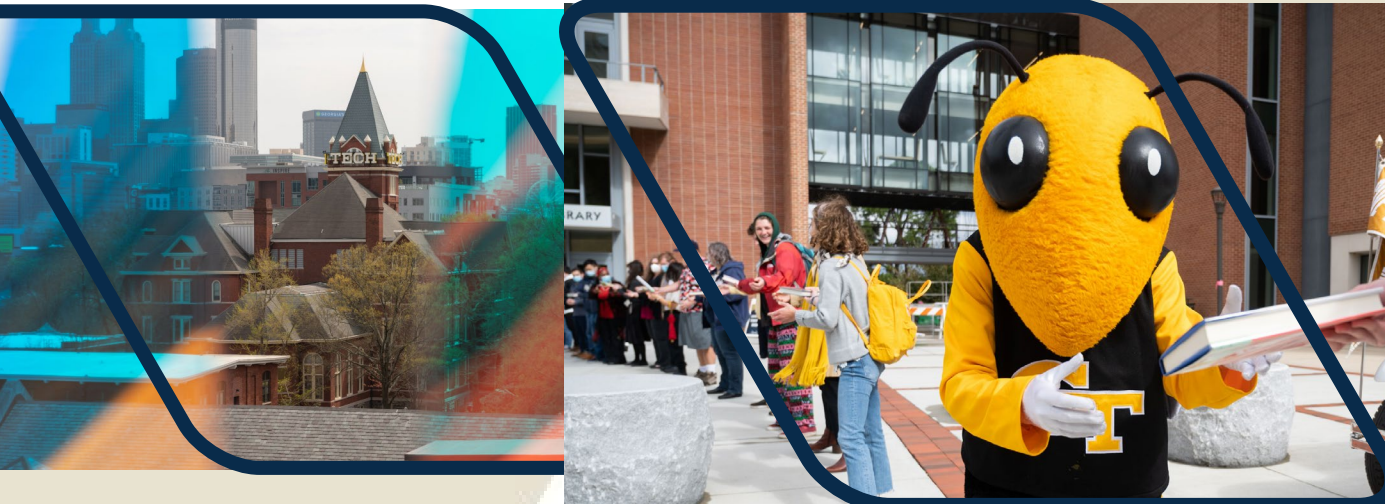
Did you know?

Did you know that Georgia Tech Library's gadgets service grew more than 200 percent in 2022, circulating nearly 14,000 instant-reservation items (chargers, headphones, calculators, laptops)? That's a savings of more than \$100,000 in fall 2022 alone.



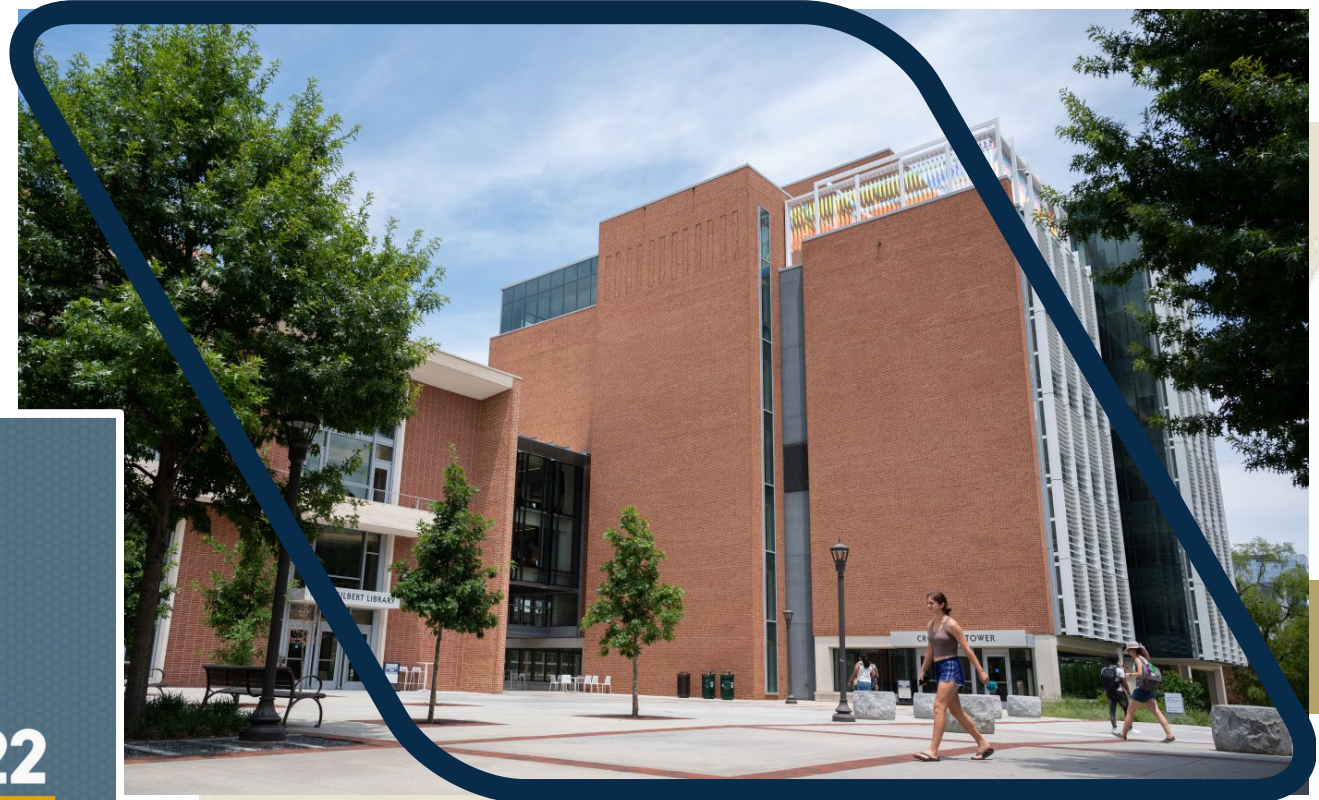
BE AUTHENTIC

Foundation Relations

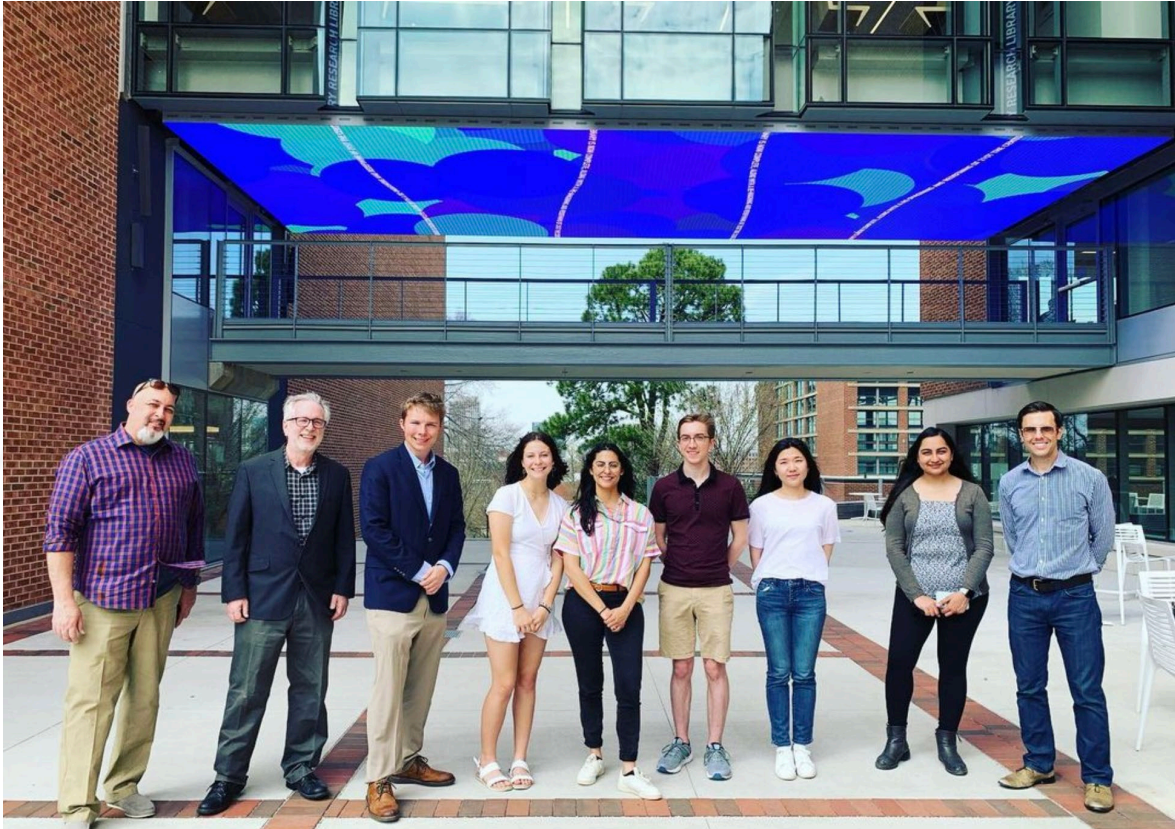
- Regularly update your contacts
